Hannah was adopted through the foster care system at age 17. Her worker wrote in her celebrations application: “She has lost a great deal in her life. Both of her parents are deceased, her mother died of breast cancer when she was eight and her father passed suddenly of a heart attack two years ago and there were no family members available to adopt her. Therefore, foster care was the only option. She has always passed all of her classes even when she was in situations where she was not supervised the way she should have been. She is interested in going to college but at this time is not certain what direction she wants to go in, but she has a wonderful adoptive family that encourages her a lot.”

Hannah’s worker requested a laptop computer through the celebrations program, to help her finish her senior year of high school and to begin to focus on college. Her worker wrote that, most of all, Hannah deserved to have something of value to call her own. An individual donated the funds and Hannah’s adoptive parents surprised her with a shopping trip to pick out the computer which her mother states “made her feel very special.”
